4. Purpose of data collection, processing and/or utilisation

7. Deadlines for deletion of data

On expiry of the deadlines issued by law or the supervisory bodies, the corresponding data will be deleted as a matter of routine. Any data to which this does not apply is deleted if it is not needed for the purposes specified in 4.
